Many of our people have read, and some have signed, your petition to stop this insanity of discrimination as proposed by Chad Smith and the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma. I wanted to take this opportunity to congratulate you for this action that you are pursuing. Also, I want to explain something that we are considering: We may also post a very similar petition in the same place. Our logic is this, though we will no doubt end up with the same Total signatures on both our petitions, we felt it might improve the chances of actually being looked at by those in Washington, DC if they saw more Nations and/or Tribes being represented. We by no means wish you to feel that we are encroaching or being disrespectful to your honored group. Our people wish to honor your efforts by mirroring them. In effect, we add our names to your petition but are adding our "Nation" to the battle as well. We have not yet created the petition and I await your respected opinion of our proposal.

Cherokee Nation Declares War On Its Own Blood!

O'Siyo My Brothers and Sisters,

My name is Chief Marvin Walking Bear Tucker. Some of you know me, some of you do not and some of you could care less who I am. We held a Chiefs Meeting in Winston Salem NC on July 10th-12th to discuss what we can do to stop the Cherokee Nation of OK (CNO) and the Eastern Band of Cherokee from doing what they are doing to their own blood.

There were several Chiefs from all over the USA there who signed the Peace Treaty. We invite you to join in the Coalition. If you care about the rights of your people then this is the time to speak up. There is power in numbers. Together we stand, divided we fall and I don't want to fall any further.

If the CNO and Eastern Band do not want to except members then why do they not just close enrollment? and I must assume that out of the 5 tribes that were denied recognition in Tennessee, that only 1 was native American, sorry that does not work out. So out of the 4 tribes deleted there were no native Americans. I also think that these two groups need to remember who walked that trail, I will bet my best hunting knife that they were not all Cherokee. So now you be the judge, should these groups of individuals, this corporation (CNO) or the Eastern Band have the right to judge what is delegated to the state governments.

I know you have heard about what the CNO is doing. If you haven't heard then this is what they intend to do in congress. They are representing themselves as the only Cherokee People in this country, and they want the Congress of The United States to make it a law. They want to make it unlawful to call yourself Cherokee if you don't live on the reservation. They are stating that the only Cherokee People in this country are the ones that are listed on the Dawes Roll and only if you live on the reservation can you claim the bloodline. To me this is the same thing Hitler wanted to do with the world. Hitler wanted only blue eyed, blond hair and fair skin people to live on this earth.

Well The CNO has started something that I don't think they considered. They have declared war against their own blood Brothers and Sisters that out number them by several million. Now that isn't very good planning on their part. They have awakened a sleeping giant that will not stand for being bullied around anymore.

I am here to talk about something very important to all of us. In the past we have been standing alone against our Enemy's and getting no where fast. I am here to talk to you about bringing the Gathering together of all Cherokee Nations into one Nation. Now is the time to make the prophesy come true. We have to stand together if we are to survive. No one can stand in the way of a Cherokee Tribe that is 2 million strong, not even the great CNO.

In my opinion this is the only way we can live in the Cherokee way. By signing a peace treaty with all Cherokee people and agreeing to work together to stop the ones that would like to see our way of life die. There is power in numbers if we want to stay who we are (and we are the Principal People) We are the Cherokee people and if I have to go to the end of my days fighting alone I will do so. No one Tribal Council can take that away from us, unless we stand by and do nothing.

Now, Chief Jim Wilson and I have been working on this for several months and all we need is for you, as (Honorable Chiefs and Elders) to come to an agreement here and join with us as one Nation, The United Cherokee People of America coalition.
